01 1. The AI-Empowered Scrum Master

- How AI changes Scrum Master work across the week, not just in one event
- What AI should and should not do with team data, coaching, and decisions
- Where human judgment stays in the seat — conflict, trust, and facilitation

02 2. Working Effectively with AI

- Context that actually changes the output — board, notes, and constraints

- Turn the read into a conversation the team can act on

04 4. AI-Powered Scrum Events

- Sprint Planning prep: goal options, capacity, and ready work
- Daily Scrum: surface risks without turning the meeting into a status read
- Sprint Review: evidence, outcomes, and stakeholder questions
- Retrospectives: themes, patterns, and follow-through after the room

05 5. Backlog & Story Analysis

- Story quality and acceptance criteria before refinement
- Splitting work and naming dependencies the team will actually hit
- Readiness checks so refinement is a decision, not a rewrite
- What stays with the Product Owner and what the Scrum Master can unblock

06 6. AI for Coaching & Facilitation

- Coaching questions that stay human — AI drafts, you decide
- Difficult conversations: prep, not a script you read in the room
- Team dynamics and facilitation planning for the week ahead
- Where a model has no business being in the conversation

07 7. Creating Reusable AI Skills

- Turn repeatable Scrum Master activities into reusable AI skills
- Name the job, the input, and the output so someone else can run it
- Keep the skill usable next sprint, not just in class
- Version and improve a skill after the first real week

08 8. Sprint Health Skill

- Analyze sprint information from the tools you already use
- Produce risks, blockers, and trends in language the team recognizes
- Recommended actions the team can take this increment
- A health read you can run on a cadence, not as a one-off

09 9. Facilitation & Retrospective Skills

- Meeting preparation: purpose, prompts, and timeboxes
- Retrospective analysis from notes and patterns, not vibes
- Action tracking after the room so items do not die in a doc
- A facilitation pack you can reuse for Planning, Review, and Retro

10 10. Designing Automated Workflows

- Trigger → AI analysis → decision → action
- Identifying good automation candidates in Scrum Master admin
- Where a human still has to decide before anything ships to the team

07 · AI IN THIS COURSE

Day 1 is skills. Day 2 is the system.

Twelve modules across two days. Day 1 puts AI on the work a Scrum Master already runs. Day 2 turns that work into reusable skills and automated workflows, and closes on a capstone you take back to your team.
